In March 2019, Special Camps became a 501\(c\)3 as the ESG Foundation, Inc., found on social media as the Special Camps Foundation. The name ESG was chosen to honor our roots and those who had a great impact on our ministry – Euler, Stephens, Gattis. Barbara Euler, Larry Stephens, and Judy Gattis are just three of the many individuals who sculpted Special Camps through the years and made it what it is today. We made the decision to establish a 501(c)3 to ensure the sustainability and healthy growth of our camping programs and ministry. Our vision is to bring joy and enrichment to the lives of special needs individuals. We
